- One membership equals one vote.
- Suppliers to the flooring trade may apply for membership at the same status and cost to trades people. However suppliers are only allowed one membership and one vote.
- The CFAQ reserves the right to deny membership for any reason.
- Should The CFAQ deny membership, a full refund of all dues paid will be provided after notification has been made to the applicant.
- Once accepted, all members will be able to take full advantage of Member Benefits including product training, the use of an exclusive forum and other services, as they become available to The CFAQ.
- The CFAQ reserves the right to revoke membership should a member be found to be in violation of these terms and conditions, or for any reason be deemed to bring The CFAQ brand into disrepute.
- Members may terminate their membership status by notifying The CFAQ in writing. However, once an application for membership has been accepted, there will be no refunds of membership fees.
- Members must be in good standing (i.e., be up to date with their fees and not in violation of any Rule or Regulation of The CFAQ published from time to time) in order to maintain their membership status.
